During this panel, David discussed the *amicus brief* Selendy Gay filed on behalf of two scholars associated with the Williams Institute in *United States, et al. v. Skrmetti*, a case in which the Supreme Court will determine the constitutionality of Tennessee's ban on the provision of gender-affirming medical care to minors. He also discussed the suit that the firm recently filed alongside the ACLU to strike down South Carolina's ban on gender-affirming care.
